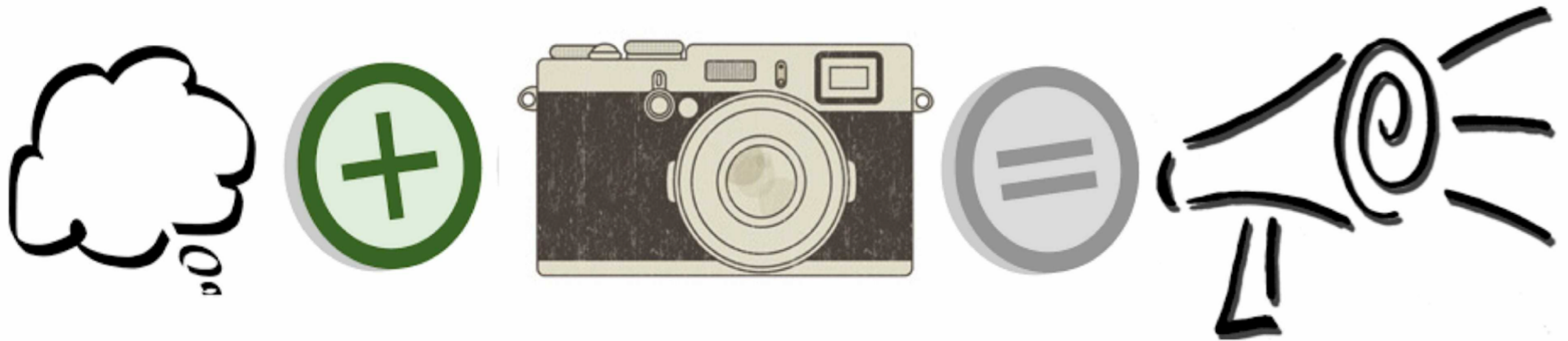

Participatory Action Research

- Centralizes the voices and experiences of marginalized folx
- Challenge researcher as the expert role
- Provides guidelines for power-sharing
- Importance of interpersonal connection between researchers and co-researchers


Photovoice Methodology

Purpose of the Project

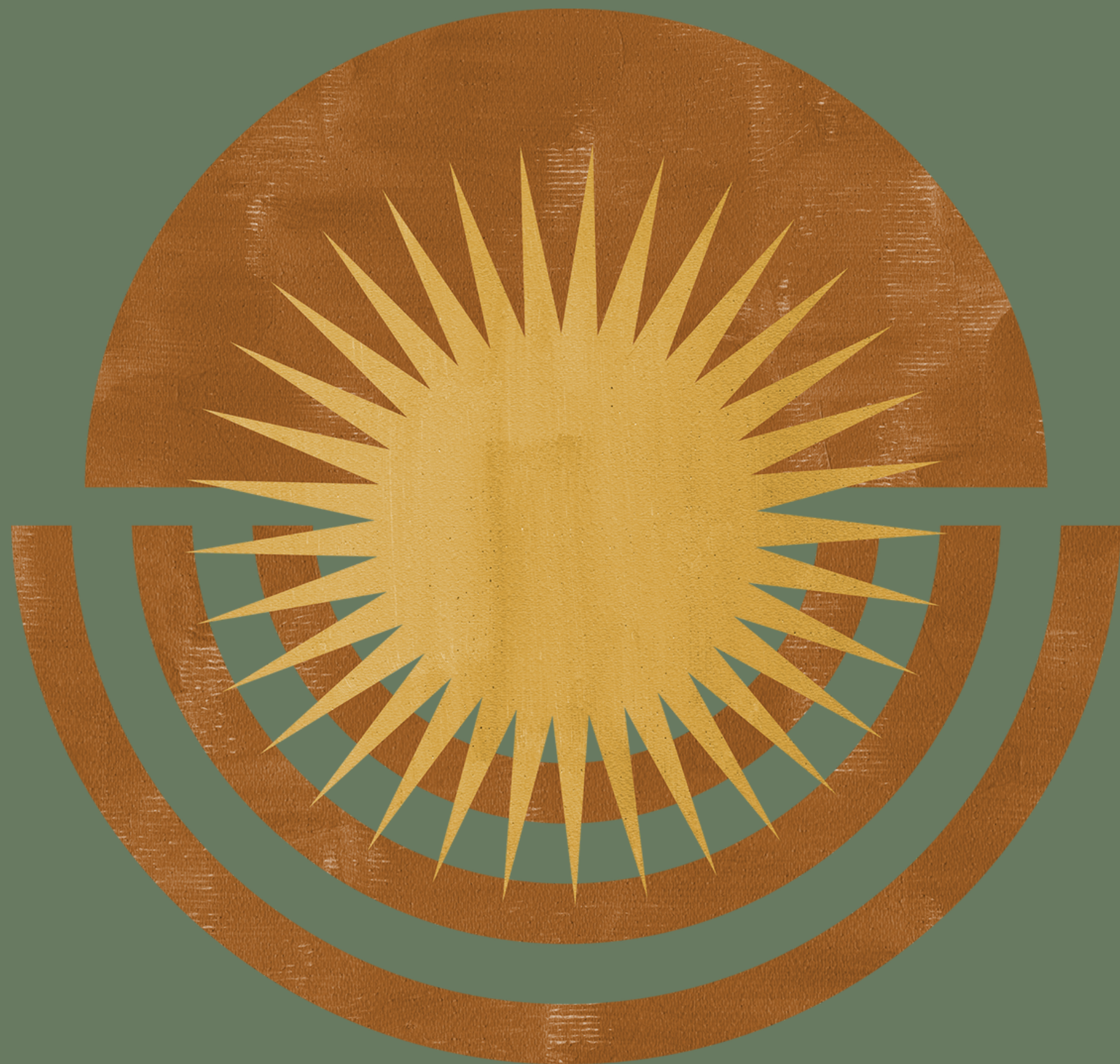
- Explore Queer Womxn of Color (QWoC) experiences of microaggressions in therapy;
- Identify the needs and strengths of their community through visual images and storytelling;
- Engage in critical dialogue regarding individual and community needs/concerns for the expansion of critical consciousness; and
- Engage in social advocacy.
